Mystery quilt Clue 1:

Use what ever method you would like to make 56 (total) nine patches.

- Option one: cut 602 2 ½ X 2 ½ assorted prints and 280- 2 ½ X 2 ½ background.. Using 5 background squares and 4 print squares, piece together to make nine patches The extra print squares will be used later in the quilt.
- Option two: strip piece 2 ½ strips of assorted scraps and 2 ½ strips of background. Subcut into 2 ½ sections. Piece together to make a 9 patch. Press seam allowances toward the print when possible. Square up to 6 ½ inches. See examples below.
