

Mystery quilt Clue 1:

Use what ever method you would like to make 56 (total) nine patches.

Option one: cut 602 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ X $2\frac{1}{2}$ assorted prints and 280- $2\frac{1}{2}$ X $2\frac{1}{2}$ background.. Using 5 background squares and 4 print squares, piece together to make nine patches The extra print squares will be used later in the quilt.

Option two: strip piece $2\frac{1}{2}$ strips of assorted scraps and $2\frac{1}{2}$ strips of background . Subcut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ sections. Piece together to make a 9 patch. Press seam allowances toward the print when possible. Square up to $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches. See examples below.
