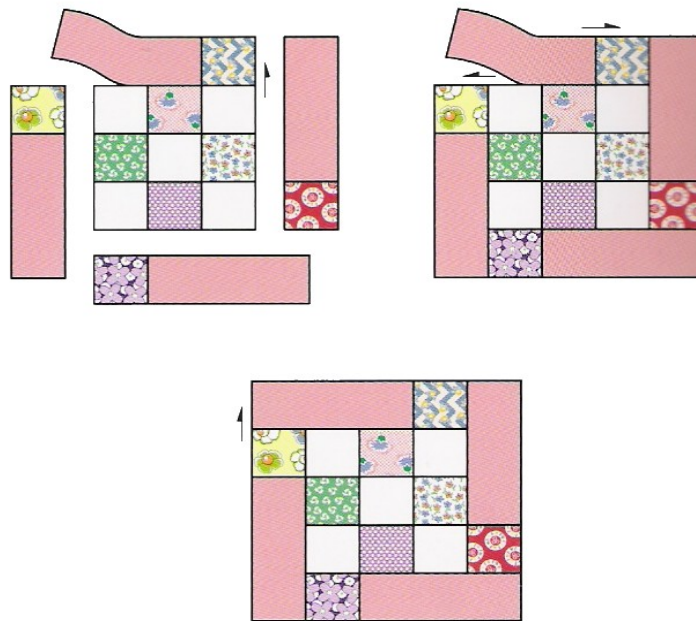


## Mystery Quilt Clue 3:

### To Make Block B:

1. Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch print square to the end of a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch Solid appearing fabric. Press seam allowance toward the print square. It takes 4 of these to make one block. Using the last 28 of the nine patches from clue 1, sew one rectangle unit to the nine patch unit stopping 1 inch from the end of the nine patch. Attach the second, third, and fourth rectangle in a clockwise direction around the nine patch. See Example.



Block B.  
Make 28.

Note: Place these blocks in a zip lock bag and mark as BLOCK B.

\*\*Note. Press Blocks A (28) and Blocks B (28). Size the blocks to  $10\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Keep these blocks separate.
